

**Assembly Bill No. 529**

CHAPTER 145

An act to amend Section 5006.1 of the Penal Code, relating to corrections.

[Approved by Governor July 17, 1995. Filed with Secretary of State July 18, 1995.]

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 529, Setencich. Corrections: Inmate Welfare Fund.

Existing law provides that money in the Inmate Welfare Fund shall not be expended to pay charges for special event staff overtime, television repair and recordings, athletic and recreation supplies, athletic uniforms, and original complement of television sets and replacement of television equipment, but that the Department of Corrections shall pay those charges out of any money appropriated for those purposes.

This bill would delete television recordings and athletic uniforms from the list of charges for which the money in the Inmate Welfare Fund may not be expended.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 5006.1 of the Penal Code is amended to read:

5006.1. Notwithstanding any provision in Section 5006, money in the Inmate Welfare Fund shall not be expended to pay charges for any or all of the following purposes:

- (a) Overtime for staff coverage of special events.
- (b) Television repair.
- (c) Athletic and recreation supplies.
- (d) Original complement of television sets and replacement of television equipment.

The department shall pay these charges out of any money appropriated for these purposes.
