An act to add Section 1725.5 to the Insurance Code, relating to insurance.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 702, as introduced, Cunneen. Insurance: license number.

Existing law relating to insurance, for purposes of regulating various categories of licensees, specifies various requirements of licensure.

This bill would require, commencing January 1, 1997, those licensees to prominently affix or cause to be printed on printed materials his or her license number. The term printed material would be defined to include letterhead, business cards, and printed advertisements. The Insurance Commissioner would be authorized to adopt regulations to implement that requirement.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1725.5 is added to the Insurance
2 Code, to read:
3 1725.5. (a) For purposes of Sections 1625, 1626,
4 1724.5, 1758.1, 1765, 14020, and 15006, every licensee shall

1 prominently affix or cause to be printed on printed
2 material his or her license number. For purposes of this
3 requirement, printed material includes letterhead,
4 business cards, and printed advertisements. Printed
5 material does not include an insurance policy or contract,
6 or proof of insurance certificates.

7 (b) In the case of transactors, organizational licensee
8 numbers may be used.

9 (c) The commissioner may adopt regulations
10 implementing the requirements of this section.

11 (d) This section shall become operative January 1,
12 1997.
