An act to amend Sections ~~11009 and 11553~~ *11553 and 11553.5* of the Government Code, relating to state government.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 926, as amended, Rainey. State boards and commissions.

~~(1) Existing law provides that, except as otherwise provided by law, a member of a state board or commission shall serve without compensation, but is to be allowed necessary expenses incurred in the performance of duty.~~

~~This bill would prohibit a member of a state board or commission who serves as a board or commission member for less than 24 hours a week to receive any wage, salary, or per diem, but would permit these persons to be reimbursed if documentation is provided for reasonable travel, meals, and mileage expenses related to board or commission activity.~~

~~(2) Existing~~

~~Existing law provides for an annual salary of \$81,635 to be paid to the chairperson, president, or administrative director of various state boards and commissions, as specified. Existing law provides for an annual salary of \$79,122 to be paid to the~~



members of various state boards and commissions, as specified.

This bill would reduce the annual salary for those persons to \$72,500.
