An act to add Section 10709 to the Public Contract Code, relating to the California State University Contract Law.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1520, as introduced, McPherson. California State University: energy conservation construction contracts.

Existing law, the California State University Contract Law, establishes procedures for the letting of contracts by the Trustees of the California State University, subject to specified exceptions. Existing law authorizes a public agency, subject to specified conditions, to enter into an energy service contract and a facility ground lease, or facility financing contract and a facility ground lease, or an energy sale contract. This provision does not apply to the California State University.

This bill would authorize the Trustees of the California State University to enter into an energy conservation construction contract on the terms it determines are in the best interests of the California State University, as specified.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 10709 is added to the Public
2 Contract Code, to read:

1 10709. Notwithstanding Sections 10705 and 10708 and
2 any other provision of law to the contrary, the trustees
3 may enter into an energy conservation construction
4 contract, on the terms it determines are in the best
5 interests of the California State University if they find that
6 the anticipated cost for the alterations effected by the
7 energy conservation construction contract will be less
8 than the anticipated marginal cost to the California State
9 University of energy that would have been consumed by
10 the California State University in the absence of those
11 alterations.
