An act to amend Section 19549 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to horseracing.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1879, as introduced, Machado. Allocation of racing days.

Existing law provides for the allocation of a maximum of 14 days to the California Exposition and State Fair or a county or district agricultural association fair or citrus fair. Those racing days are required to be days on which general fair activities are conducted.

This bill would require those days to be in the calendar period in which general fair activities are conducted.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 19549 of the Business and
2 Professions Code is amended to read:
3 19549. Except as provided in Section 19549.1, the
4 maximum number of racing days ~~which~~ *that* may be
5 allocated to the California ~~State Fair and~~ Exposition ~~or~~
6 ~~California and~~ State ~~Exposition and~~ Fair or a county or
7 district agricultural association fair or citrus fair shall be

1 14 days per year. ~~Such~~ *Those* racing days shall be days ~~on~~
2 *in the calendar period in* which general fair activities are
3 conducted. However, any fair racing association ~~which~~
4 *that* conducted racing in the central or southern zone
5 prior to January 1, 1980, shall be entitled to be allocated
6 up to three weeks of racing.
