

**Assembly Bill No. 2278**

CHAPTER 82

An act to add Section 23433.5 to the Business and Professions Code, relating to alcoholic beverages.

[Approved by Governor June 30, 1996. Filed with  
Secretary of State July 1, 1996.]

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2278, Battin. Alcoholic beverages: licenses: club.

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Act defines the term "club" for purposes of club licenses to include any golf club, which owns, maintains, or operates a regular golf links together with a clubhouse thereon.

This bill would provide that a club license for a golf club entitles the licensee to make sales of alcoholic beverages from any golf cart, as defined, operating on the golf club premises.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 23433.5 is added to the Business and Professions Code, to read:

23433.5. A club license issued for any golf club, as described in Section 23426, entitles a licensee to make sales of alcoholic beverages from any golf cart, as defined in Section 345 of the Vehicle Code, operating on the golf club premises.
