An act to add Section 40106 to the Health and Safety Code, relating to air pollution.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2666, as introduced, Knight. Air pollution: districts: Antelope Valley.

(1) Under existing law, there is a county air pollution control district in every county, unless the county is included within one of specified air pollution control districts or air quality management districts.

This bill would provide that the portion of the Antelope Valley which is located in Northern Los Angeles County shall constitute the territory of the Los Angeles County Air Pollution Control District, which the bill would create. The bill would create a state-mandated local program by imposing new duties on the county.

(2) The California Constitution requires the state to reimburse local agencies and school districts for certain costs mandated by the state. Statutory provisions establish procedures for making that reimbursement.

This bill would provide that no reimbursement is required by this act for a specified reason.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: yes.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 40106 is added to the Health and  
2 Safety Code, to read:

3 40106. Notwithstanding Section 40410 or any other  
4 provision of this part, that portion of the Antelope Valley  
5 which is located in Northern Los Angeles County shall  
6 constitute the territory of the Los Angeles County Air  
7 Pollution Control District, which is hereby created.

8 SEC. 2. No reimbursement is required by this act  
9 pursuant to Section 6 of Article XIII B of the California  
10 Constitution because a local agency or school district has  
11 the authority to levy service charges, fees, or assessments  
12 sufficient to pay for the program or level of service  
13 mandated by this act, within the meaning of Section 17556  
14 of the Government Code.

15 Notwithstanding Section 17580 of the Government  
16 Code, unless otherwise specified, the provisions of this act  
17 shall become operative on the same date that the act  
18 takes effect pursuant to the California Constitution.
