LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 3483, as introduced, Assembly Committee on Budget. Medi-Cal.

Existing law provides for the Medi-Cal program, administered by the State Department of Health Services, under which qualified low-income persons are provided with health care services.

This bill would express the intent of the Legislature to make the statutory changes necessary to implement the Budget Act of 1996 relative to the Medi-Cal program.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature, in
2 enacting this act, to make the statutory changes necessary
3 to implement the Budget Act of 1996 relative to the
4 Medi-Cal program.

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
