CHAPTER 707

An act to add Section 29.1 to the Mojave Water Agency Law (Chapter 2146 of the Statutes of 1959), relating to the Mojave Water Agency.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 386, Rogers. Mojave Water Agency: capital facilities.

Existing law provides for the Mojave Water Agency and authorizes the agency's board to undertake specified functions for purposes of providing sufficient water for the lands and inhabitants of the agency.

This bill would authorize the agency to issue improvement bonds under prescribed existing acts.

This bill would also set forth legislative findings and declarations.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The Legislature finds and declares that the Mojave Water Agency is involved in water resources management programs that require construction and operation of new facilities to the maximum extent possible in order to ensure the availability of water resources within its jurisdiction.

SEC. 2. Section 29.1 is added to the Mojave Water Agency Law (Chapter 2146 of the Statutes of 1959), to read:

Sec. 29.1. The agency may issue improvement bonds in accordance with, and pursuant to, the Improvement Act of 1911 (Division 7 (commencing with Section 5000) of the Streets and Highways Code), the Improvement Bond Act of 1915 (Division 10 (commencing with Section 8500) of the Streets and Highways Code), the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913 (Division 12 (commencing with Section 10000) of the Streets and Highways Code), the Refunding Assessment Bond Act of 1935 (Chapter 732 of the Statutes of 1935), and the Revenue Bond Law of 1941 (Chapter 6 (commencing with Section 54300) of Part 1 of Division 2 of Title 5 of the Government Code).
