An act to add Section 35415 to the Vehicle Code, relating to vehicles.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1463, as introduced, Johannessen. Vehicles: lengths.

Existing law prohibits vehicles operated on the highway from exceeding specified maximum lengths.

This bill would exempt from those maximum length provisions a trailer that is used to transport vehicles that compete in motorsports competition events, if the distance from the kingpin to the rearmost axle of the trailer does not exceed 46 feet.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 35415 is added to the Vehicle  
2 Code, to read:  
3 35415. The limitations as to length of vehicles  
4 contained in this chapter do not apply to a trailer that is  
5 used to transport vehicles that compete in motorsports  
6 competition events, if the distance from the kingpin to  
7 the rearmost axle of the trailer does not exceed 46 feet.
