An act relating to the Department of the Youth Authority, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1760, as introduced, Committee on Budget and Fiscal Review. Youth Authority.

Existing law sets forth the powers and duties of the Department of the Youth Authority, as specified.

This bill would, operative July 1, 1996, declare the intent of the Legislature with respect to implementing the Budget Act of 1996 relative to the Department of the Youth Authority.

The bill would declare that it is to take effect immediately as an urgency statute.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature in
2 enacting this act to make the necessary statutory changes
3 to implement the Budget Act of 1996 relative to the
4 Department of the Youth Authority.

5 SEC. 2. This act shall become operative on July 1,
6 1996.

7 SEC. 3. This act is an urgency statute necessary for the
8 immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or



1 safety within the meaning of Article IV of the
2 Constitution and shall go into immediate effect. The facts
3 constituting the necessity are:

4 In order to become operative at the same time as the
5 Budget Act of 1996, it is necessary that this act take effect
6 immediately as an urgency statute.
