Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 105—Relative to the Tom Taylor Bridge.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 105, as introduced, Oller. Tom Taylor Bridge.

This measure would designate a specified new bridge on State Highway Route 26, in Calaveras County, the Tom Taylor Bridge. The measure would also request the Department of Transportation to determine the cost of appropriate plaques and markers showing the special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources covering that cost, to erect those plaques and markers.

Fiscal committee: yes.

- 1 WHEREAS, The recent completion of the new bridge,  
2 crossing the Middle Fork of the Mokelumne River near  
3 West Point on State Highway Route 26, provides an  
4 opportunity for honoring former Calaveras County  
5 Board of Supervisor, Tom Taylor; and  
6 WHEREAS, Tom Taylor was born and raised in  
7 Calaveras County and has spent most of his very active  
8 life in the West Point-Rail Road Flat area of the county;  
9 and

1 WHEREAS, Tom Taylor was a four-term member of  
2 that county's board of supervisors, serving from 1980  
3 through 1996; and

4 WHEREAS, Tom Taylor has been a tireless  
5 representative of Calaveras County, and specifically  
6 Supervisorial District 2; and

7 WHEREAS, Public safety and the well-being of  
8 Calaveras County residents has always been of utmost  
9 concern to Supervisor Taylor; and

10 WHEREAS, Tom Taylor constantly pursued road  
11 improvements as a high priority for the county and his  
12 district; and

13 WHEREAS, Supervisor Taylor was instrumental in the  
14 pursuit of funding for the new bridge; and

15 WHEREAS, The recent completion of this new bridge  
16 provides the citizens of this state and particularly the  
17 citizens of Calaveras County with the opportunity to  
18 dedicate that bridge to Tom Taylor; now, therefore, be it

19 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the*  
20 *Senate, thereof concurring,* That the bridge crossing the  
21 Middle Fork of the Mokelumne River near West Point on  
22 State Highway Route 26 in Calaveras County is hereby  
23 officially designated the Tom Taylor Bridge; and be it  
24 further

25 *Resolved,* That the Department of Transportation is  
26 requested to determine the cost of appropriate plaques  
27 and markers, consistent with the signing requirements  
28 for the state highway system, showing the special  
29 designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate  
30 sources covering that cost, to erect those plaques and  
31 markers; and be it further

32 *Resolved,* That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly  
33 transmit a copy of this resolution to the Director of  
34 Transportation.
