LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1589, as amended, Committee on Budget. Local government.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature to make the necessary statutory changes to implement the Budget Act of 1997 relative to local government.

~~The bill would declare that it is to take effect immediately as an urgency statute.~~

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature in
2 enacting this act to make the necessary statutory changes
3 to implement the Budget Act of 1997 relative to local

2 ~~immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or~~
