Introduced by Assembly Member Sweeney

An act to amend Section 76102 of the Government Code, relating to law enforcement.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1681, as introduced, Sweeney. Suspect identification system: digital image.

Existing law authorizes the board of supervisors of any county to establish in the county treasury an Automated Fingerprint Identification Fund, funded as specified, out of which moneys are disbursed for specified costs relating to automated fingerprint equipment.

This bill would, in addition, authorize the board of supervisors of any county to establish similar funding for digital photographic equipment used to identify persons who are booked as a result of having been arrested or charged with a crime.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 76102 of the Government Code
2 is amended to read:
3 76102. (a) For the purpose of assisting any county in
4 the establishment of adequate fingerprint facilities *and*

1 *adequate digital image photographic suspect booking*
 2 *identification facilities* in the county, the board of
 3 supervisors may establish in the county treasury an
 4 Automated Fingerprint Identification *and Digital Image*
 5 *Photographic Suspect Booking Identification System*
 6 Fund into which shall be deposited the amounts specified
 7 in the resolutions adopted by the board of supervisors as
 8 authorized in accordance with this title. The moneys of
 9 the fund shall be payable only for the purchase, lease,
 10 operation, including personnel and related costs, and
 11 maintenance of automated fingerprint equipment and
 12 ~~the digital image photographic equipment,~~ replacement
 13 of existing automated fingerprint equipment, ~~or for the~~
 14 *and digital image photographic equipment,* and
 15 reimbursement of local agencies within the county which
 16 have previously purchased, leased, operated, or
 17 maintained automated fingerprint equipment *and digital*
 18 *image photographic equipment* from other funding
 19 sources.

20 (b) For purposes of this section ~~“automated,~~ *the*
 21 *following terms have the following meanings:*

22 (1) *“Automated fingerprint equipment”* means that
 23 equipment designated for the storage or retrieval of
 24 fingerprint data which is compatible with the California
 25 Identification System Remote Access Network.

26 (2) *“Digital photographic equipment”* means that
 27 equipment designed for the capture, storage, retrieval, or
 28 transmittal of digital photographic images of persons who
 29 are booked as a result of having been arrested or charged
 30 with a crime.

31 (c) The fund moneys shall be held by the county
 32 treasurer separate from any funds subject to transfer or
 33 division pursuant to Section 1463 of the Penal Code.
 34 Deposits to the fund may continue through and including
 35 the 20th year after the initial calendar year in which the
 36 surcharge is collected, or longer if and as necessary to
 37 make payments upon any lease or leaseback arrangement
 38 utilized to finance any of the projects specified herein.

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
