Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 22—Relative to the State Highway Route 156 Hollister Bypass Project.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SCR 22, as amended, McPherson. State Highway Route 156 Hollister Bypass Project: designation.

This measure would designate the State Highway Route 156 Hollister Bypass Bridge crossing the San Benito River the Ed Hanna Memorial Bridge and would designate the bypass itself the Veterans Memorial Highway. The Department of Transportation would be requested to determine the cost of appropriate plaques and markers showing these special designations and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources sufficient to cover that cost, to erect appropriate plaques and markers.

Fiscal committee: yes.

- 1 WHEREAS, The State Highway Route 156 Hollister
- 2 Bypass is nearing completion; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The bypass will include construction of a
- 4 new bridge crossing the San Benito River which is to be
- 5 designated 43-44; and

1 WHEREAS, Ed Hanna was a longtime county
2 employee, having worked in the ~~1940s~~ 1940's as the
3 county surveyor and also worked as the county engineer
4 and road commissioner; and

5 WHEREAS, Ed Hanna was a respected member of the
6 County Engineers Association; and

7 WHEREAS, It is appropriate that the new bridge
8 crossing the San Benito River be dedicated to the
9 memory of Ed Hanna, and that the bypass be named in
10 honor of ~~the military~~ veterans of ~~many wars~~; now,
11 therefore, be it

12 *Resolved by the Senate of the State of California, the*
13 *Assembly thereof concurring,* That the bridge designated
14 43-44 on the State Highway Route 156 Hollister Bypass is
15 hereby officially designated the Ed Hanna Memorial
16 Bridge, and that the State Highway Route 156 Hollister
17 Bypass is hereby officially designated the Veterans
18 Memorial Highway; and be it further

19 *Resolved,* That the Department of Transportation is
20 requested to determine the cost of appropriate plaques
21 and markers, consistent with the signing requirements of
22 the state highway system, showing ~~those~~ *these* special
23 designations and, upon receiving donations from
24 nonstate sources sufficient to cover that cost, to erect
25 appropriate plaques and markers showing these special
26 designations; and be it further
