2 Association (PTA), the oldest and largest child advocacy
3 organization in the state, has worked on behalf of
4 California’s children for 100 years; and

5 WHEREAS, Since its founding in 1897, the California
6 State PTA has grown to more than one million members
7 working to improve the lives of all children, youth, and
8 families; and

9 WHEREAS, Throughout its history, the California
10 State PTA has been dedicated to promoting public
11 policies that improve the education and well-being of all
12 children and youth; and

13 WHEREAS, The California State PTA actively supports
14 and promotes parent and public involvement in the
15 schools and in the community; and

16 WHEREAS, The California State PTA continues to
17 assist parents in developing the skills they need to nurture
18 their children and to work cooperatively with schools and
19 communities on issues that affect children; and

20 WHEREAS, The California State PTA celebrates its
21 100th anniversary on February 17, 1997; now, therefore,
22 be it

23 *Resolved by the Senate of the State of California, the*
24 *Assembly thereof concurring,* That, in recognition of the
25 100th anniversary of the founding of the California State
26 Parent Teacher Association, February 1997 be designated
27 Parent Teacher Association Month in California; and be

30 and honors the California State Parent Teacher
31 Association for its 100 years of caring about children,
