SENATE BILL

No. 143

Introduced by Senator Kopp

An act to amend Sections 6252 and 6258 of, to amend and renumber Section 6253 of, to add Sections 6252.5 and 6253 to, to add a heading as Article 1 (commencing with Section 6250) to Chapter 3.5 of, to add Article 2 (commencing with Section 6275) to Chapter 3.5 of, Division 7 of Title 1 of, and to repeal Sections 6253.1, 6256, 6256.1, 6256.2, and 6257 of, the Government Code, relating to records.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 143, as amended, Kopp. Records.

(1) Existing provisions of the California Public Records Act require each state and local agency, as defined, to make its records open to public inspection at all times during office hours, except as specifically exempted from disclosure by law. The act also defines the terms "writing," "person," and "member of the public."

This bill would revise the definitions of local agency and "writing" and would define "public agency." The bill would also provide for public inspection of public records and copying in all forms, as specified. The bill would further require public agencies to ensure that systems used to collect

and hold public records be designed to ensure ease of public access.

This bill would expressly state that notwithstanding the definition of “member of the public,” an elected member or officer of any state or local agency is entitled to access to public records of that agency on the same basis as any other person and would state that it is declaratory of existing law.

This bill would incorporate changes made to the California Public Records Act by the Governor’s Reorganization Plan of 1991, including adding the Department of Toxic Substances Control and the Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment to the list of state and local bodies that are required to establish written guidelines for accessibility of records.

(2) Existing law provides that the California Public Records Act shall not be construed to require disclosure of records, the disclosure of which is exempted or prohibited by provisions of federal or state law.

This bill would list specific provisions of law coming within that exemption.

By requiring a higher level of service of local agencies in administering the California Public Records Act, this bill would impose a state-mandated local program.

(3) Under the act, any person is authorized to institute proceedings for injunctive or declaratory relief or writ of mandate to enforce that person’s right to inspect or to receive a copy of any public record or class of public records.

This bill would limit this authorization to apply for judicial relief under the act to persons who submitted a written request for a public record and that request was denied.

(4) The California Constitution requires the state to reimburse local agencies and school districts for certain costs mandated by the state. Statutory provisions establish procedures for making that reimbursement, including the creation of a State Mandates Claims Fund to pay the costs of mandates which do not exceed \$1,000,000 statewide and other procedures for claims whose statewide costs exceed \$1,000,000.

This bill would provide that, if the Commission on State Mandates determines that this bill contains costs mandated by



the state, reimbursement for those costs shall be made pursuant to those statutory procedures and, if the statewide cost does not exceed \$1,000,000, shall be made from the State Mandates Claims Fund.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A heading as Article 1 (commencing with Section 6250) is added to Chapter 3.5 of Division 7 of Title 1 of the Government Code, to read:

Article 1. General Provisions

SEC. 2. Section 6252 of the Government Code is amended to read:

6252. As used in this chapter:

(a) "State agency" means every state office, officer, department, division, bureau, board, and commission or other state body or agency, except those agencies provided for in Article IV (except Section 20 thereof) or Article VI of the California Constitution.

(b) "Local agency" includes a county; city, whether general law or chartered; city and county; school district; municipal corporation; district; political subdivision; or any board, commission or agency thereof; other local public agency; or nonprofit organizations or entities that are legislative bodies of a local agency pursuant to ~~subdivision (e)~~ subdivisions (c) and (d) of Section 54952.

(c) "Person" includes any natural person, corporation, partnership, limited liability company, firm, or association.

(d) "Public agency" means any state or local agency.

(e) "Public records" includes any writing containing information relating to the conduct of the public's business prepared, owned, used, or retained by any state or local agency regardless of physical form or characteristics. "Public records" in the custody of, or

1 maintained by, the Governor's office means any writing
2 prepared on or after January 6, 1975.

3 (f) "Writing" means handwriting, typewriting,
4 printing, photostating, photographing, and every other
5 means of recording upon any form of communication or
6 representation, including letters, words, pictures, sounds,
7 or symbols, or combination thereof, and all papers, maps,
8 magnetic or paper tapes, photographic films and prints,
9 magnetic or punched cards, discs, drums, and other
10 documents.

11 (g) "Member of the public" means any person, except
12 a member, agent, officer, or employee of a federal, state,
13 or local agency acting within the scope of his or her
14 membership, agency, office, or employment.

15 SEC. 3. Section 6252.5 is added to the Government
16 Code, to read:

17 6252.5. Notwithstanding the definition of "member of
18 the public" in Section 6252, an elected member or officer
19 of any state or local agency is entitled to access to public
20 records of that agency on the same basis as any other
21 person. Nothing in this section shall limit the ability of
22 elected members or officers to access public records
23 permitted by law in the administration of their duties.

24 This section does not constitute a change in, but is
25 declaratory of, existing law.

26 SEC. 4. Section 6253 of the Government Code is
27 amended and renumbered to read:

28 6253.4. (a) Every agency may adopt regulations
29 stating the procedures to be followed when making its
30 records available in accordance with this section.

31 The following state and local bodies shall establish
32 written guidelines for accessibility of records. A copy of
33 these guidelines shall be posted in a conspicuous public
34 place at the offices of these bodies, and a copy of the
35 guidelines shall be available upon request free of charge
36 to any person requesting that body's records:

2 are open for inspection as prescribed in Section 6253.

3 SEC. 5. Section 6253 is added to the Government
4 Code, to read:

5 6253. (a) Public records are open to inspection at all
6 times during the office hours of the state or local agency
7 and every person has a right to inspect any public record,
8 except as hereafter provided. Any reasonably segregable
9 portion of a record shall be available for inspection by any
10 person requesting the record after deletion of the
11 portions that are exempted by law.

12 (b) Except with respect to public records exempt
13 from disclosure by express provisions of law, each state or
14 local agency, upon a request for a copy of records that
15 reasonably describes an identifiable record or records,
16 shall make the records promptly available to any person,
17 upon payment of fees covering direct costs of duplication,
18 or a statutory fee, if applicable. Upon request, an exact
19 copy shall be provided unless impracticable to do so.
20 Agencies shall provide a copy of an electronic record in
21 the form requested, unless, in light of surrounding
22 circumstances, it is not reasonable to do so, provided that
23 the requested form is one which is used by the agency.
24 Electronic copies of records shall be made promptly
25 available upon payment of fees as follows:

26 (1) Except when the records are requested for a
27 commercial purpose, electronic copies of records shall be
28 made available upon payment of fees representing the
29 direct cost of duplication or a statutory fee. For purposes
30 of this section, “commercial purpose” means any use that
31 furthers the commercial, trade, or profit interests of the
32 requester or person on whose behalf the request is made.
33 Commercial purpose does not include the following:

34 (A) A request made by a nonprofit corporation
35 exempt from taxation pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of
36 Title 26 of the United States Code, so long as the
37 information requested is not used for any purpose in
38 which the corporation would be required to pay income
39 tax under state or federal law.

1 (B) A request made by a person who, through contract
2 or employment, is a publisher, editor, or reporter with a
3 news gathering organization and makes the request in
4 that capacity and use is limited to a news gathering
5 purpose.

6 (2) For requests in which the information is to be used
7 for any commercial purpose, the records shall be made
8 available upon payment of the actual cost of providing the
9 record, which may include the costs of search, retrieval,
10 review, segregation, and duplication.

11 (3) If a request is made pursuant to paragraph (1) or
12 (2), the requester shall certify the fee category that
13 applies to the request.

14 Except as authorized by this subdivision, no other fees
15 may be charged for copies of records required to be
16 disclosed pursuant to this article.

17 Nothing in this subdivision pertaining to information
18 maintained in electronic form expands, modifies, or limits
19 any requirement, exemption, or other provision
20 contained elsewhere in this chapter.

21 (c) Each agency, upon a request for a copy of records
22 shall, within 10 days from receipt of the request,
23 determine whether the request, in whole or in part, seeks
24 copies of disclosable public records in the possession of
25 the agency and shall promptly notify the person making
26 the request of the determination and the reasons
27 therefor. In unusual circumstances, the time limit
28 prescribed in this section may be extended by written
29 notice by the head of the agency or his or her designee to
30 the person making the request setting forth the reasons
31 for the extension and the date on which a determination
32 is expected to be dispatched. No notice shall specify a date
33 that would result in an extension for more than 14 days.
34 As used in this section, “unusual circumstances” means,
35 but only to the extent reasonably necessary to the proper
36 processing of the particular request:

37 (1) The need to search for and collect the requested
38 records from field facilities or other establishments that
39 are separate from the office processing the request.

1 (2) The need to search for, collect, and appropriately
2 examine a voluminous amount of separate and distinct
3 records which are demanded in a single request.

4 (3) The need for consultation, which shall be
5 conducted with all practicable speed, with another
6 agency having substantial interest in the determination
7 of the request or among two or more components of the
8 agency having substantial subject matter interest therein.

9 (d) Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to
10 permit an agency to obstruct the inspection or copying of
11 public records. Any notification of denial of any request
12 for records shall set forth the names and titles or positions
13 of each person responsible for the denial.

14 (e) Except as otherwise prohibited by law, a state or
15 local agency may adopt requirements for itself that allow
16 for faster, more efficient, or greater access to records than
17 prescribed by the minimum standards set forth in this
18 chapter.

31 6258. Any person who has submitted a written
32 request for a public record and that request has been
33 denied or the agency to which the written request was
34 directed has failed to timely respond as required by
35 Section 6253 may institute proceedings for injunctive or
36 declarative relief or writ of mandate in any court of
37 competent jurisdiction to enforce his or her right to
38 inspect or to receive a copy of that public record or class
39 of public records under this chapter. The times for
40 responsive pleadings and for hearings in these

1 proceedings shall be set by the judge of the court with the
2 object of securing a decision as to these matters at the
3 earliest possible time.

4 SEC. 12. Article 2 (commencing with Section 6275) is
5 added to Chapter 3.5 of Division 7 of Title 1 of the
6 Government Code, to read:

8 Article 2. Other Exemptions from Disclosure
9

10 6275. It is the intent of the Legislature to assist
11 members of the public and state and local agencies in
12 identifying exemptions to the California Public Records
13 Act. It is the intent of the Legislature that, after January
14 1, 1999, each addition or amendment to a statute that
15 exempts any information contained in a public record
16 from disclosure pursuant to subdivision (k) of Section
17 6254 shall be listed and described in this article. The
18 statutes listed in this article may operate to exempt
19 certain records, or portions thereof, from disclosure. The
20 statutes listed and described may not be inclusive of all
21 exemptions. The listing of a statute in this article does not
22 itself create an exemption. Requesters of public records
23 and public agencies are cautioned to review the
24 applicable statute to determine the extent to which the
25 statute, in light of the circumstances surrounding the
26 request, exempts public records from disclosure.
