An act relating to the Department of Fish and Game, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1107, as introduced, Committee on Budget. Department of Fish and Game: implementation of the Budget Act of 1999.

Under existing law, there is in the Resources Agency the Department of Fish and Game, which is vested with specified duties, powers, purposes, and responsibilities related to the management of wildlife resources.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature to make the necessary statutory changes to implement the Budget Act of 1999 relative to the funding of the Department of Fish and Game.

This bill would declare that it is to take effect immediately as an urgency statute.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature in  
2 enacting this act to make the necessary statutory changes  
3 to implement the Budget Act of 1999 relative to the  
4 funding of the Department of Fish and Game.

5 SEC. 2. This act is an urgency statute necessary for the  
6 immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or  
7 safety within the meaning of Article IV of the  
8 Constitution and shall go into immediate effect. The facts  
9 constituting the necessity are:

10 In order to make the necessary statutory changes to  
11 implement the Budget Act of 1999 at the earliest possible  
12 time, it is necessary that this act take effect immediately.
