ASSEMBLY BILL

An act to amend ~~Section 44930~~ *Sections 44930 and 45201* of the Education Code, relating to ~~certificated~~ school employees.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1135, as amended, Ashburn. ~~Certificated-school~~ *School* employees: resignations.

Existing law prohibits the resignation of a certificated school employee from taking effect after the close of the school year during which the governing board of a school district receives the resignation.

This bill would, notwithstanding the above, authorize an employee and the governing of a school district to agree that a resignation will be accepted at a mutually agreed upon date *not later than 2 years* beyond the close of the school year during which the resignation is received by the board.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 44930 of the Education Code is
2 amended to read:

1 44930. (a) Governing boards of school districts shall
2 accept the resignation of any employee and shall fix the
3 time when the resignation takes effect, which, except as
4 provided by subdivision (b), shall not be later than the
5 close of the school year during which the resignation has
6 been received by the board.

7 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an
8 employee and the governing *board* of a school district
9 may agree that a resignation will be accepted at a
10 mutually agreed upon date *not later than two years*
11 beyond the close of the school year during which the
12 resignation is received by the board.

13 *SEC. 2. Section 45201 of the Education Code is*
14 *amended to read:*

15 45201. (a) The governing boards of any school
16 district may accept the resignation of any employee and
17 may fix the time when the resignation shall take effect,
18 which, *except as noted in subdivision (b)*, shall not be
19 later than the close of the school year during which the
20 resignation is received by the board.

21 (b) *Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an*
22 *employee and the governing board of a school district*
23 *may agree that a resignation will be accepted at a*
24 *mutually agreed upon date not later than two years*
25 *beyond the close of the school year during which the*
26 *resignation is received by the board.*
