An act to add Section 6254.17 to the Government Code, relating to records.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1312, as introduced, Machado. Records: administrative regulations.

Under the California Public Records Act, public records are generally open to inspection at all times during the office hours of the respective agency, except for certain records that are exempt from mandatory disclosure.

This bill would provide that nothing in the act shall be construed to exempt from disclosure any report or analysis that forms any part of an agency's decision to adopt, amend, or repeal an administrative regulation.
