An act to add Section 670.2 to the Streets and Highways Code, relating to highways.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1460, as introduced, Oller. Department of Transportation: permits.

Under existing law, the construction and maintenance of state highway facilities is done by the Department of Transportation. Existing law allows the department to issue permits in connection with state highway facilities.

This bill would make any requirement in a permit issued by the department after January 1, 1997, that requires the City of Jackson in Amador County to own a storm drainage system as a condition of allowing a development in that city, void and enforceable.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 670.2 is added to the Streets and
- 2 Highways Code, to read:
- 3 670.2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
- 4 any term or condition in a permit issued by the

1 department pursuant to this article after January 1, 1997,
2 that requires the City of Jackson in Amador County to
3 own a storm drainage system as a condition of allowing a
4 development in that city, is void and unenforceable.

5 SEC. 2. The Legislature finds and declares that a
6 special statute is necessary and that a general statute
7 cannot be made applicable, within the meaning of
8 Section 16 of Article IV of the California Constitution,
9 because of the unique circumstances and resulting
10 burdens applicable only to the City of Jackson in Amador
11 County.
