CHAPTER _____

An act to amend Section 6525 of the Government Code, relating to local government.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1511, Florez. Joint powers authority: mutual water company.

Existing law authorizes public agencies to enter into joint exercise of power agreements to jointly exercise any power common to the contracting agencies and to issue bonds pursuant to the Marks-Roos Local Bond Pooling Act of 1985. Existing law expressly authorizes a mutual water company to enter into a joint powers agreement with any public agency for the purpose of exercising any power common to the contracting agencies.

This bill would provide instead that a mutual water company may enter into a joint powers agreement validly entered into by public agencies, but that a mutual water company shall not be considered a member of the authority for specified purposes.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 6525 of the Government Code is amended to read:

6525. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, a mutual water company may enter into a joint powers agreement that has been validly entered into by public agencies pursuant to this chapter for the purpose of jointly exercising any power common to the contracting parties.

However, a mutual water company shall not be considered a member of the authority for purposes of Section 6586.5.

SEC. 2. The Legislature finds and declares that Section 1 of this act, which amends Section 6525 of the Government Code, is declaratory of existing law.
