An act to amend Section 890 of the Penal Code, relating to grand juries.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1796, as amended, Papan. Grand jurors: compensation.

Existing law provides that unless a higher fee or rate of mileage is otherwise provided by statute or county or city and county ordinance, the fees for grand jurors are \$10 a day for each day's attendance as a grand juror, and 15¢ a mile, in going only, for each mile actually traveled in attending court as a grand juror.

This bill would provide, instead, that unless a higher fee or rate of mileage is otherwise provided by statute or county or city and county ordinance, the fees for grand jurors are \$25 a day for each day's attendance as a grand juror and the mileage reimbursement applicable to ~~state~~ *county* employees for each mile actually traveled in attending court as a grand juror.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:
