An act to repeal Sections 31470.10 and 31470.11 of the Government Code, relating to welfare fraud investigators and administrators.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1947, as introduced, Maldonado. County Employees Retirement Law of 1937: safety membership.

Existing provisions of the County Employee Retirement Law of 1937 specify that specified Orange County welfare fraud investigators and administrators, and Santa Barbara County welfare fraud and child support investigators and administrators, except as specified, are not eligible for safety membership in the county retirement system.

This bill would repeal these provisions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.
