An act relating to the realignment of funding of state and local health programs, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2875, as introduced, Committee on Budget. State and local health program funding.

Existing law establishes and regulates various public health programs.

This bill would state the intent of the Legislature to make the necessary statutory changes to implement the Budget Act of 2000 relative to the funding of the realignment of state and local health programs.

This bill would declare that it is to take effect immediately as an urgency statute.

Vote: $\frac{2}{3}$. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature in
2 enacting this act to make the necessary statutory changes

1 to implement the Budget Act of 2000 relative to the
2 funding of the realignment of state and local health
3 programs.

4 SEC. 2. This act is an urgency statute necessary for the
5 immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or
6 safety within the meaning of Article IV of the
7 Constitution and shall go into immediate effect. The facts
8 constituting the necessity are:

9 In order to make the necessary statutory changes to
10 implement the Budget Act of 2000 at the earliest possible
11 time, it is necessary that this act take effect immediately.
