Senate Resolution No. 23—Relative to Kenneth L. Maddy.

1 WHEREAS, The Honorable Kenneth L. Maddy, late a  
2 Senator from the 14th District, has concluded a life of  
3 illustrious service to the people of California and the  
4 California State Senate; and

5 WHEREAS, Senator Maddy, elected to the Assembly in  
6 1970 and to the Senate in 1979, served nearly 20 years in  
7 this house in a myriad of leadership roles, most notably  
8 Chairman of the Republican Caucus, Senate Republican  
9 Leader from 1987 to 1995, and Member of the Budget  
10 Conference Committee and key negotiator in the  
11 conclusion of budget deliberations; and

12 WHEREAS, Senator Maddy championed significant  
13 legislation in a broad range of policy areas including horse  
14 racing, ethics, regulation of agriculture, criminal justice,  
15 water, land use, welfare reform, and the provision of  
16 medical services to the people of this state; and

1 WHEREAS, Throughout his legislative career, Senator  
2 Ken Maddy upheld the highest standards of legislative  
3 service in his dedication and respect for this house and its  
4 members, embodying the spirit of collegiality and healthy  
5 compromise, drawing from each member his or her  
6 particular wisdom and best qualities in the production of  
7 public policy, standing in constant reminder of the joy of  
8 service and the joy of life; now therefore, be it

9 *Resolved by the Senate of the State of California,* That  
10 the Senate hereby designates Room 3195 of the State  
11 Capitol, that portion of the Senate chambers serving as  
12 the Members' Lounge, as the Kenneth L. Maddy Lounge;  
13 and be it further

14 *Resolved,* That the Rules Committee shall cause to be  
15 placed at the entrance to Room 3195 a plaque  
16 appropriately commemorating Senator Maddy, and shall  
17 commission a portrait of the Senator to be hereafter  
18 prominently displayed within the Kenneth L. Maddy  
19 Lounge.
