Relative to Kenneth L. Maddy

WHEREAS, The Honorable Kenneth L. Maddy, late a Senator from the 14th District, has concluded a life of illustrious service to the people of California and the California State Senate; and

WHEREAS, Senator Maddy, elected to the Assembly in 1970 and to the Senate in 1979, served nearly 20 years in this house in a myriad of leadership roles, most notably Chairman of the Republican Caucus, Senate Republican Leader from 1987 to 1995, and Member of the Budget Conference Committee and key negotiator in the conclusion of budget deliberations; and

WHEREAS, Senator Maddy championed significant legislation in a broad range of policy areas including horse racing, ethics, regulation of agriculture, criminal justice, water, land use, welfare reform, and the provision of medical services to the people of this state; and

WHEREAS, Throughout his legislative career, Senator Ken Maddy upheld the highest standards of legislative service in his dedication and respect for this house and its members, embodying the spirit of collegiality and healthy compromise, drawing from each member his or her particular wisdom and best qualities in the production of public policy, standing in constant reminder of the joy of service and the joy of life; now therefore, be it

*Resolved by the Senate of the State of California,* That the Senate hereby designates Room 3195 of the State Capitol, that portion of the Senate Chambers serving as the Members’ Lounge, as the Kenneth L. Maddy Lounge; and be it further

*Resolved,* That the Rules Committee shall cause to be placed at the entrance to Room 3195 a plaque appropriately commemorating Senator Maddy, and shall commission a portrait of the Senator to be hereafter prominently displayed within the Kenneth L. Maddy Lounge.
