INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF SENATE MEASURES

The following measures were introduced, read the first time and transmitted to the Committee on Rules for assignment:

Senate Bill 104: By Senator Ortiz—An act to amend Section 101317 of, and to add Sections 100106 and 101029 to the Health and Safety Code, relating to public health.

Senate Bill 105: By Senator Speier (Principal coauthor: Senator Soto) (Principal coauthor: Assembly Member Torrico)—An act to amend Sections 21175 and 21192 of the Government Code, relating to public employees' retirement.



Senate Bill 106: By Senator Dunn—An act to amend Section 18400.1 of, to amend and repeal Section 18502 of, and to repeal Section 18424 of, the Health and Safety Code, relating to mobilehome parks.

Senate Bill 107: By Senators Simitian and Perata—An act to amend Sections 25740, 25743, and 25744 of, and to repeal Sections 25745 and 25749 of, the Public Resources Code, and to amend Sections 387, 399.11, 399.12, 399.13, 399.14, 399.15, and 399.16 of, to add Section 399.17 to, and to add Article 9 (commencing with Section 635) to Chapter 3 of Part 1 of Division 1 of, the Public Utilities Code, relating to energy.

Senate Bill 108: By Senator Lowenthal—An act to amend Section 1369 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to health care service plans.

Senate Bill 109: By Senator Ortiz—An act to amend Section 39153 of, and to repeal Section 42400.7 of, the Health and Safety Code, relating to air pollution.
