INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF SENATE MEASURES

The following measures were introduced, read the first time and transmitted to the Committee on Rules for assignment:

Senate Bill 215: By Senator Denham—An act to add Section 96.11 to the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to local government finance.

Senate Bill 216: By Senator Cox—An act to amend Section 674 of the Code of Civil Procedure, and to amend Section 4506 of the Family Code, relating to abstracts of judgment.

Senate Bill 217: By Senator Cogdill—An act to amend Section 82011 of the Government Code, relating to the Political Reform Act of 1974.



Senate Bill 218: By Senator Steinberg—An act relating to education.

Senate Bill 219: By Senator Steinberg—An act to amend Section 52052 of the Education Code, relating to pupil achievement.

Senate Bill 220: By Senator Corbett—An act to amend Section 12108 of, and to add Section 12109 to, the Business and Professions Code, and to amend Sections 111070, 111115, 111130, and 111170 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to drinking water.

Senate Bill 221: By Senator Runner—An act to amend Section 9359.1 of the Government Code, relating to the Legislators' Retirement System.

CONSIDERATION OF DAILY FILE SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS

Senate Bill 115—An act relating to the administration of unemployment compensation, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

Bill read second time.

The amendments proposed by the Committee on Labor and Industrial Relations were read and adopted and the measure ordered printed, and re-referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

Senate Bill 113—An act to amend Sections 1000, 1001, 1201, and 1202 of the Elections Code, relating to elections.

The amendments proposed by the Committee on Appropriations were read and adopted and the measure ordered printed, engrossed, and to third reading.

Senate Bill 116—An act to add Sections 1252.3 and 1279.1 to the Unemployment Insurance Code, relating to unemployment compensation, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

Bill read second time.

The amendments proposed by the Committee on Labor and Industrial Relations were read and adopted and the measure ordered printed, and re-referred to the Committee on Appropriations.
