### INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF SENATE MEASURES

The following measures were introduced, read the first time and transmitted to the Committee on Rules for assignment:

**Senate Bill 123:** By Senator Liu—An act to amend Section 53086 of the Education Code, relating to career development.

**Senate Bill 124:** By Senator Oropeza—An act to amend Section 42407 of, and to add Chapter 3.4 (commencing with Section 39640) to Part 2 of Division 26 of, the Health and Safety Code, relating to air pollution.

**Senate Bill 125:** By Senator Benoit—An act to add Section 5028.5 to the Penal Code, relating to undocumented criminal aliens.
