Second Reading of Bills—Author's Amendments

Senate Bill 36—An act to amend Sections 10140.6, 10150, 10235.5, and 10236.4 of, to add Article 2.1 (commencing with Section 10166.01) to Chapter 2 of Division 4 of, and to repeal Section 10131.8 of, the Business and Professions Code, relating to mortgages.

Bill read second time.

The amendments were read and adopted and the measure ordered printed and re-referred to the committee.

Senate Bill 131: By Senator Wiggins—An act to amend Section 25500.1 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to alcoholic beverages.

Senate Bill 132: By Senator Denham—An act to add Chapter 7.8 (commencing with Section 3575) to Division 2 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to healing arts, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

Senate Bill 133: By Senator Corbett—An act to add Article 9.3 (commencing with Section 31142.20) to Chapter 1 of Part 5 of Division 12 of the Water Code, relating to the Alameda County Water District.
