INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF SENATE MEASURES

The following measures were introduced, read the first time and transmitted to the Committee on Rules for assignment:

Senate Bill 138: By Senator Liu—An act to amend Section 7287 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to local taxation.

Senate Bill 139: By Senator Kehoe—An act to add Section 6009 to the Public Resources Code, and to amend Sections 2, 14, 19, 21, 30.5, 51, 57, and 68 of the San Diego Unified Port District Act (Chapter 67 of the Statutes of 1962, First Extraordinary Session), relating to tidelands and submerged lands.



Senate Bill 140: By Senator Corbett—An act to add Article 3 (commencing with Section 6941) to Chapter 2 of Part 3 of Division 4 of the Food and Agricultural Code, relating to nurseries, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

Senate Bill 141: By Senator Maldonado—An act to amend and repeal Section 11257 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to CalWORKs.

Senate Bill 142: By Senator Maldonado—An act to amend Section 1501 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to health care facilities.

Senate Bill 143: By Senator Cedillo—An act to amend and renumber the heading of Article 2 (commencing with Section 25395.115) of Chapter 6.83, and to repeal Article 8 (commencing with Section 25395.109) of Chapter 6.82, and Article 1 (commencing with Section 25395.110) of Chapter 6.83, of Division 20 of, the Health and Safety Code, relating to hazardous materials.

Senate Bill 144: By Senator Pavley—An act to add Section 4556 to the Public Resources Code, relating to forest resources.

Senate Bill 145: By Senator DeSaulnier—An act to amend Sections 3600 and 4663 of the Labor Code, relating to workers' compensation.

Senate Bill 146: By Senator Cox—An act to amend Section 349 of the Streets and Highways Code, relating to highways.

Senate Concurrent Resolution 14: By Senator Aanestad—Relative to Prostate Cancer Awareness Month.

Senate Concurrent Resolution 15: By Senator Wiggins—Relative to Earth Hour.
