INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF SENATE MEASURES

The following measures were introduced, read the first time and transmitted to the Committee on Rules for assignment:

Senate Bill 142: By Senator DeSaulnier—An act to repeal Chapter 1 (commencing with Section 99000) and Chapter 2 (commencing with Section 99100) of Part 11 of Division 10 of the Public Utilities Code, relating to transportation.

Senate Bill 143: By Senator Fuller—An act to amend Section 42285.5 of the Education Code, relating to education finance, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.



Senate Bill 144: By Senator Cannella—An act to add Chapter 6.4 (commencing with Section 30030) to Division 3 of Title 3 of the Government Code, relating to criminal justice realignment, and making an appropriation therefor.
