**Senate Bill 1010:** By Senator Mitchell—An act to amend Section 11006 of the Penal Code, relating to the Department of Justice.

**Senate Bill 1011:** By Senator Monning—An act to amend Section 5005.1 of the Corporations Code, relating to corporations.

**Senate Bill 1012:** By Senator Wyland—An act to amend Section 4980.43 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to marriage and family therapists.

**Senate Bill 1013:** By Senator Berryhill—An act to amend Section 22202 of the Financial Code, relating to finance lenders.

**Senate Bill 1014:** By Senator Jackson—An act to add Section 4068.1 to the Business and Professions Code, to amend Section 117700 of, and to add Section 117670.1 to, the Health and Safety Code, and to add Article 3.4 (commencing with Section 47120) to Chapter 1 of Part 7 of Division 30 of the Public Resources Code, relating to pharmaceutical waste.
