Assembly Bill 467—An act to add Section 4046 to, and to add Article 11.5 (commencing with Section 4169.5) to Chapter 9 of Division 2 of, the Business and Professions Code, and to amend Sections 150201, 150202, and 150205 of, and to add Section 150208 to, the Health and Safety Code, relating to pharmaceuticals, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
