INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING OF SENATE MEASURES

The following measures were introduced, read the first time and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure Development:

Senate Bill 7: By Senator Allen—An act to amend, repeal, and add Sections 6051.8 and 6201.8 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation, and making an appropriation therefor, to take effect immediately, tax levy.

Senate Bill 8: By Senator Hill (Coauthors: Senators Allen, Block, Galgiani, Hancock, Liu, McGuire, Pan, and Roth)—An act to amend Section 39719 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to public transit, and making an appropriation therefor.

Senate Bill 9: By Senator Moorlach (Coauthors: Senators Anderson, Bates, Fuller, Huff, Nielsen, Runner, Stone, and Vidak)—An act to add Section 14009 to, and to add Article 2.6 (commencing with Section 14140) to Chapter 2 of Part 5 of Division 3 of Title 2 of, the Government Code, relating to transportation.



Senate Bill 10: By Senators Bates and Nguyen (Coauthors: Senators Anderson, Fuller, Gaines, Huff, Runner, Stone, and Vidak) (Coauthors: Assembly Members Baker and Bigelow)—An act to amend Sections 14524, 14525, 14527, 14529, 14529.1, 14529.8, and 65082 of, and to repeal Section 14530 of, the Government Code, and to amend Sections 164 and 193 of, to add Section 182.1 to, to repeal Sections 182.5 and 188.11 of, and to repeal and add Section 188.8 of, the Streets and Highways Code, relating to transportation.

Senate Bill 11: By Senator Berryhill (Coauthors: Senators Anderson, Bates, Fuller, Gaines, Huff, Morrell, Runner, Stone, and Vidak) (Coauthor: Assembly Member Bigelow)—An act to amend Section 21080.37 of the Public Resources Code, relating to the California Environmental Quality Act.

Senate Bill 12: By Senator Runner (Coauthors: Senators Anderson, Fuller, Gaines, Huff, Moorlach, Stone, and Vidak) (Coauthor: Assembly Member Bigelow)—An act to amend Sections 13975, 14500, and 14526.5 of, and to repeal Section 14534.1 of, the Government Code, relating to transportation.

Senate Bill 13: By Senator Vidak (Coauthors: Senators Anderson, Fuller, Gaines, Huff, Runner, and Stone) (Coauthors: Assembly Members Baker and Bigelow)—An act to add Part 5.1 (commencing with Section 14460) to Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code, relating to transportation.

Senate Bill 14: By Senator Cannella (Principal coauthor: Assembly Member Perea) (Coauthors: Senators Anderson, Bates, Berryhill, Fuller, Gaines, Huff, Morrell, Nielsen, Stone, and Vidak)—An act to amend Section 143 of the Streets and Highways Code, relating to transportation.
