**Senate Bill 1:** By Senators Perata, Machado, and Steinberg—An act to add Division 33 (commencing with Section 83000) to the Water Code, relating to water, and making an appropriation therefor.

*(The following measures were introduced on September 19, 2007.)*

**Senate Bill 2:** By Senators Perata, Machado, and Steinberg—An act to add Division 26.7 (commencing with Section 79700) to the Water Code, relating to financing a water supply reliability and environmental restoration program, by providing the funds necessary therefor through an election for the issuance and sale of bonds of the State of California and for



the handling and disposition of those funds, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

**Senate Bill 3:** By Senators Cogdill and Ackerman—An act to add Division 26.7 (commencing with Section 79700) to the Water Code, relating to financing a water supply reliability and environmental restoration program, by providing the funds necessary therefor through an election for the issuance and sale of bonds of the State of California and for the handling and disposition of those funds.

**Senate Bill 4:** By Senator Cogdill (Coauthor: Assembly Member Villines)—An act to add Division 33 (commencing with Section 83000) to the Water Code, relating to water, and making an appropriation therefor.

**Senate Bill 5:** By Senator Wiggins (Coauthor: Assembly Member Berg)—An act to add Section 6217.3 to the Public Resources Code, relating to public resources, and making an appropriation therefor.
