**Second Reading of Bills—Author's Amendments**

**Senate Bill 2**—An act to add Division 26.7 (commencing with Section 79700) to the Water Code, relating to financing a water supply reliability and environmental restoration program, by providing the funds necessary therefor through an election for the issuance and sale of bonds of the State of California and for the handling and disposition of those funds, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

Bill read second time.

The amendments were read and adopted and the measure ordered printed and re-referred to the committee.
