INTRODUCTION OF SENATE MEASURES

The following measures were introduced and transmitted to the Committee on Rules:

Senate Bill 1: By Senator Wyland—An act to add Section 8543.9 to the Government Code, relating to the State Auditor.

Senate Bill 2: By Senator Cox—An act to amend and repeal Section 130105 of, to repeal Sections 130110, 130115, 130120, 130125, 130130, 130135, 130140, 130140.1, 130145, 130150, 130151, and 130155 of, and to repeal and add Section 130100 of, the Health and Safety Code, relating to child development, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.

Senate Constitutional Amendment 1: By Senator Wyland—A resolution to propose to the people of the State of California an amendment to the Constitution of the State, by amending, repealing, and adding Sections 3, 8, 10, 11, and 12 of Article IV thereof, by amending, repealing, and adding Section 6 of Article XIX thereof, and by amending, repealing, and adding Section 1 of Article XIXA thereof, relating to legislative sessions.

Senate Constitutional Amendment 2: By Senator Wyland—A resolution to propose to the people of the State of California an amendment to the Constitution of the State, by amending Section 1 of Article XIX B thereof, relating to transportation.
