Senate Bill 1—An act to amend Sections 10601.5, 10802, 10804, 47602, and 60900 of, to add Article 10 (commencing with Section 48350) to Chapter 2 of Part 27 of Division 4 of Title 2 of, and to add Article 5 (commencing with Section 52065) to Chapter 6.1 of Part 28 of Division 4 of Title 2 of, the Education Code, relating to public schools, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately.
