Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 148—Relative to the Armenian Martyrs Memorial.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 148, as amended, Charles Calderon. Armenian Genocide Martyrs Memorial.

This measure would request that the Department of Transportation erect informational signs on State Highway Route 60 in the County of

Los Angeles directing motorists to the Armenian Genocide Martyrs Monument, consistent with the signing requirements for the state highway system and upon receiving donations from nonstate sources sufficient to cover the cost to erect those signs.

Fiscal committee: yes.

1 WHEREAS, The Armenian Genocide Martyrs Monument was
2 erected in 1965 in Bicknell Park in the City of Montebello; and

3 WHEREAS, The Armenian Genocide Martyrs Monument is
4 the site of religious and cultural commemorations by the Armenian
5 community in southern California; and

6 WHEREAS, The Armenian Genocide Martyrs Monument serves
7 as a beacon of awareness of all crimes against humanity; now,
8 therefore, be it

9 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*
10 *thereof concurring*, That the Legislature recognizes the importance
11 of the Armenian Genocide Martyrs Monument to the people of
12 California and requests that the Department of Transportation erect
13 informational signs on the westbound portion of State Highway
14 Route 60 leading to the Garfield Avenue exit and the eastbound
15 portion of State Highway Route 60 leading to the Garfield Avenue
16 exit, in the County of Los Angeles, directing motorists to the
17 Armenian Genocide Martyrs Monument, consistent with the
18 signing requirements for the state highway system and upon
19 receiving donations from nonstate sources sufficient to cover the
20 cost to erect those signs; and be it further

21 *Resolved*, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies
22 of this resolution to the Department of Transportation and to the
23 author for appropriate distribution.
