Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 174—Relative to the Roberto “Bobby” Salcedo Memorial Highway.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL’S DIGEST

ACR 174, as amended, Eng. Roberto “Bobby” Salcedo Memorial Highway.

This measure would designate a portion of State Highway Route 60 in the County of Los Angeles as the Roberto “Bobby” Salcedo Memorial Highway. The measure would request that the Department of Transportation determine the cost of appropriate signs showing this special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources covering that cost, erect those signs.

Fiscal committee: yes.

1 WHEREAS, Roberto “Bobby” Salcedo was a victim in a
2 senseless killing spree on December 31, 2009, in Gomez Palacio,
3 Durango, Mexico, where he and his wife Betzy were visiting her
4 family for the Christmas holidays; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Salcedo graduated in 1994 from Mountain
6 View High School in El Monte, and continued his education at
7 California State University, Long Beach, where he earned a

1 bachelor of arts degree in history, with a specialization in the
2 history of the United States and Latin America; and

3 WHEREAS, While earning his degree, Mr. Salcedo worked as
4 a program assistant in the California Student Opportunity and
5 Access (Cal-SOAP) program at Mountain View High School,
6 promoting the value of higher education and assisting students
7 with college applications and financial aid documents; and

8 WHEREAS, In 1998, Mr. Salcedo began his teaching career in
9 the Social Sciences Department at South El Monte High School,
10 where he was highly regarded as an excellent role model and an
11 enthusiastic teacher; and

12 WHEREAS, In 2004, Mr. Salcedo earned a master of arts degree
13 in educational administration at California State University, San
14 Bernardino, and was promoted to Assistant Principal of Activities
15 at South El Monte High School; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Salcedo was later appointed as Assistant
17 Principal for Instruction at Mountain View High School; and

18 WHEREAS, Most recently, Mr. Salcedo served the El Monte
19 High School District as Assistant Principal for Instruction at El
20 Monte High School, following his appointment in September,
21 2009, and also had been reelected to a third term on the Board of
22 Trustees of the El Monte City School District; and

23 WHEREAS, In addition to his commitment to education, Mr.
24 Salcedo was also extremely active in his community; and

25 WHEREAS, At the time of his death, Mr. Salcedo was working
26 on his doctorate degree at the University of California, Los
27 Angeles; and

28 WHEREAS, It is appropriate to dedicate a portion of State
29 Highway Route 60 in Mr. Salcedo's memory; now, therefore, be
30 it

31 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*
32 *thereof concurring, That the portion of State Highway Route 60*
33 *between ~~State Highway Route 710 (Interstate 710) Atlantic~~*
34 *Boulevard in the City of Monterey Park and the city limit of the*
35 *City of Rosemead in the County of Los Angeles is hereby*
36 *designated as the Roberto "Bobby" Salcedo Memorial Highway;*
37 *and, be it further*

38 *Resolved, That the Department of Transportation is hereby*
39 *requested to determine the cost of appropriate signs consistent*
40 *with the signing requirements for the state highway system showing*

1 this special designation and, upon receiving donations from
2 nonstate sources sufficient to cover that cost, to erect those signs;
3 and be it further
4 *Resolved*, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies
5 of this resolution to the Department of Transportation and to the
6 author for appropriate distribution.
