An act to amend Section 19401 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to horse racing.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 840, as introduced, Garrick. Horse racing.

Existing law expresses the Legislature's intent of the Horse Racing Law is to allow parimutuel wagering on horse races, while assuring protection of the public, among other matters.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to those provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 19401 of the Business and Professions

- 6 (b) Encouraging agriculture and the breeding of horses in this

- 9 (d) Providing for maximum expansion of horse racing
- 10 opportunities in the public interest.

- 1 (e) Providing uniformity of regulation for each type of horse
- 2 racing.

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
