An act to amend Section 69504 of the Education Code, relating to student aid.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1250, as introduced, Villines. Postsecondary education: state-funded student financial aid.

Existing law establishes various student financial aid programs that are funded by the state or a public postsecondary educational institution. Existing law provides that provisions of law applicable to state funded need-based grants do not apply to regulate the awarding of scholarships that are privately funded.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to these provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:
