An act to amend Section 53081 of the Education Code, relating to career technical education.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 569, as introduced, Steinberg. Career technical education: School-to-Career Program.

Existing law requires the State Department of Education to administer the School-to-Career Program, and, in the course of administering the program, to serve specified roles, including, but not limited to, developing or participating in the development of accountability measurements for school-to-career programs to ensure that the goals of the program are being met, and providing technical and professional assistance to all local partnerships, as defined.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to these provisions.
