An act to amend Sections 52370 and 52371 of the Education Code, relating to career technical training.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 692, as introduced, Steinberg. Career technical training.

Existing law authorizes the governing board of any high school district to provide for the maintenance on Saturday of special day and evening classes in career technical training authorized and provided for by any program of national defense of the federal government, or any agency thereof, acting through the State Department of Education. Existing law additionally authorizes school districts, upon the approval of the Superintendent of Public Instruction, to establish pilot programs to provide for the maintenance on Saturday of classes in career technical training. This training is authorized, among other things, to be a part of a program of national defense of the federal government, or any agency thereof.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to these provisions.
