An act to amend Section 18602 of the Elections Code, relating to elections.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 795, as introduced, Walters. Initiatives.

Existing law makes it a crime for a person working for the proponent of a statewide initiative or referendum to cover or obscure the Attorney General's summary of the measure from a prospective signer.

This bill would make a nonsubstantive change to this provision.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 18602 of the Elections Code is amended
- 2 to read:
- 3 18602. ~~Any~~A person working for the proponent or proponents
- 4 of a statewide initiative or referendum measure who covers or
- 5 otherwise obscures the summary of the measure prepared by the
- 6 Attorney General from the view of a prospective signer is guilty
- 7 of a misdemeanor.
