An act to amend Section 34100 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to community development.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 978, as introduced, Hollingsworth. Community development: commissions.

Existing law establishes in each community, as defined, a public body, corporate and politic, known as the community development commission, in order that a community have the option of operating and governing its redevelopment agency or redevelopment agency and housing authority, under a single operating entity and board.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to the definition of the term "community" for purposes of these provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 34100 of the Health and Safety Code is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 34100. "Community" means a city, county, city and county,
- 4 or Indian tribe, band or group which is incorporated or ~~which~~
- 5 otherwise exercises some local governmental powers.
