An act to amend Section 50075 of the Government Code, relating to local government.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1429, as introduced, Cedillo. Special taxes.

Existing law declares the intent of the Legislature to provide all cities, counties, and districts with the authority to impose special taxes, pursuant to the California Constitution.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to this provision.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 5 special taxes, pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII A of the
