An act to amend Section 5004 of the Penal Code, relating to corrections.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1282, as introduced, Fletcher. Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation.

Existing law provides for the administration of the state correctional system by the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation. Under existing law, the secretary of the department and the legislative body of any county or city may enter into agreements for mutual police aid and authorize employees of state prisons and institutions to cooperate with county and city peace officers in connection with any existing emergency, as specified.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to these provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5004 of the Penal Code is amended to

1 *those* agreements the ~~director~~ *secretary* may authorize employees
2 of state prisons and institutions to cooperate, anywhere within the
3 State, with county and city peace officers in connection with any
4 existing emergency. While so employed the employees shall have
5 all the benefits of ~~workmen's~~ *workers'* compensation laws,
6 retirement laws, and all other similar laws and for ~~such~~ *those*
7 purposes shall be deemed to be performing services in the course
8 of their regular official duties.

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
